Making Practice Musical

Of course we should still be trying to maintain good technique in everything we play, but our primary goal should always be to make something musical out of our practice! We should be excited to practice and see what music we can make that day!

How can we do that? Here are some ways in which we can make practice time more effective and more enjoyable:

- Set aside a time where you can practice without interruption. The best practice comes with efficient use of your time.
- Don't try to tackle the whole piece all at once! Take it in smaller sections where you can really focus on a particular aspect of the piece. You'll be much happier with the results and less overwhelmed when you look at the music.
- · Listen when you play! We often just play through without really paying attention to the sound we're making.

You may be overlooking a mistake or you just might miss a really wonderful musical moment! We all have pieces of music that we love listening to because they make us feel happy, or sad, or some other emotion. Do you feel any of those things with the music you make?

Listen to yourself playing and ask yourself if it is something you would enjoy listening to. No matter what you're playing, you can always have a musical moment in your practice and also in your lessons!
